

## A mentoring skills interview activity

### This is what you do...

1. Pair off with a partner for the activity.
2. Spend a few minutes independently planning a fifteen minute interview you will lead on and around mentoring skills with your partner.

Think carefully about the issues you will explore in depth on the skills, experience and ideas your partner has about what it takes to be an impressive mentor.

To help our whole-group debrief, flip chart the above.

3. When you are both ready, run the two interviews, sharing what is most significant with your interviewer.

Don't rush this, and take the time you need to fully explore the issues.

When you have completed the two interviews, capture the most immediately obvious learning points before you return to the main group.

4. Once all interviews are done, we can get back together as a whole group and share the key learning points from the activity.
